Proposed South Point Road





Project Scope – Roadway

- Shift northbound travel lanes to the east
- Expand and extend medians in corridor
- Install curb and sidewalk on east side
- Install buffer for bike lane

Why Sidewalk? Why Curb?

- Sidewalk
 - Provides safe place to walk, out of street
 - Increases access to those with mobility issues
 - Complete streets
- Curb
 - Improves drainage, channels stormwater to collection points
 - Prevents erosion of soil beyond the pavement
 - Protects edge of pavement against raveling
 - Delineates the edge of the road; keeps road from widening when re-paved, chip sealed, etc.
 - Helps keep plows in the street

Project Scope – Utilities

- Add storm sewer pipes for improved flow capacity between Acacia Ridge pond and 1000 Oaks pond(s)
 - Install median gap for overland flow of water between ponds in extreme rain events
- Street lighting in median
 - Similar to lighting north of project limits

Traffic Impacts

- Northbound travel will not be available
- Southbound travel will be limited
- Access will be maintained for driveways on South Point Road

Tentative Project Schedule

- Board of Public Works Approval: April 17th
- Common Council Approval: April 30th
- Construction begins mid–July 2019
 - Approximately 2-3 months to complete
