Gentlemen:

The 1968 Annual Report of the Madison Fire Department covering the period of January 1, 1968 through December 31, 1968, is presented for your information.

A review of the statistical data contained in this report reveals a substantial activity increase in all areas of fire service. Our emergency response figure of 5,585, which includes fire and emergency rescue ambulance calls, shows an increase of 831 over those charted for 1967. This increase can be attributed to both an enlarged population group within our city as well as to an increase in public awareness as to what services this department provides.

An intensified program in the field of Department Inspections has been started. It is the goal of this department to provide the citizens of Madison with the best fire prevention and fire protection possible and our Inspection program is geared to that premise.

The completion and occupancy of Station No. 1 and the Fire Administration Building was a highlight of the year 1968. The Administrative Offices of this department are now in one building, which has increased efficiency in this important area of fire service. The relocation of Fire Station No. 1 from Webster Street to West Dayton Street has caused a similar increase in fire response efficiency.

Awards for architectual design for our new building complex have been received from both state and local communities. We are proud of our protective facilities and I am sure this same sense of pride is shared by the citizens of our city who, along with the officials of the City of Madison, have made our Capital Improvement Program a reality.






10 - Year Experience




TOTAL FIRE LOSS - 1968
