Whereas, The City of Madison has implemented a Paid Parental Leave benefit, and,

Whereas, The Olbrich Botanical Society strives to maintain some parity with City of Madison employee benefits,

Therefore be it resolved that Olbrich Botanical Society will provide six weeks (240 hours) of paid parental leave retroactive to December 1, 2018 and that it will be added to the employee manual in a 2019 revision, and,

Let it be further resolved that the leave rules, as spelled out by the City of Madison be followed in principle by OBS employees. Employees must be in good standing and be in paid status for 1000 hours in the previous six months, employees must apply for the leave by letter with at least 30 days notice except for medical emergencies and must complete the leave in the first year after birth or adoption. The benefit is available to regular full and part-time employees (who work at least 20 hours per week) and is pro-rated based on the number of hours the employee is scheduled. Employees must return to work for at least six months following the use of paid parental leave or the value of the leave must be repaid. – Motion
