2018 Pro-Am: Champions within the Championship, A and B flight will be invited to play in the Chenequa Country Club Pro-Am with PGA Head Golf Professional, Ryan Brinza on Monday, September 17th 2018. If a Champion cannot make this date, Alternates will be as such: Champion from C Flight, Champion from D Flight, Runner up from Championship Flight, Runner up from A Flight, Runner up from B Flight, Runner up from C Flight, Runner up from D Flight and so on until the invitation is accepted. Invitations will rotate from year to year as there are only 3 invitations to give.

Optional: \$20.00 SKINS GAME paid on day one of the event will cover skins for both days. Championship and A Flights will have its own gross skins game, B and C Flights will have its own gross skins game. D Flight will have its own net skins game.

Eligibility Requirements:

Open to all public course amateur golfers.

Must have a valid WSGA Handicap from a public golf course as of 8/15/18.

High school competitors may only accept the championship trophy due to WIAA regulations regarding Amateur Status.

Rainout Procedure: If in the unlikely event of inclement weather, all players have completed 9 holes, but not all players have completed 18-holes, the daily event scores will be based on 9-holes. If any players fail to complete 9-holes due to weather, the day will be cancelled and the event will become an 18-hole competition.

If inclement weather cancels play on one day, but not the other, rain checks will be issued for the course that was to be played.

If inclement weather cancels play on both days, entry fees will be returned to players in the form of City of Madison Gift Cards.

<u>Tiebreaking Procedure</u>: Any players competing for the overall Public Links Championship will play a sudden death playoff beginning on Hole #1 and following holes in succession until a Champion is determined.

(NOTE): Only players in the Championship and A Flight may challenge for the overall Championship.

Any ties within A, B, C and D flights will be broken by a sudden death scorecard playoff starting at the #1 handicap hole and following in succession by handicap holes until a Flight Champion is determined.

<u>Payouts</u>: Each flight will pay out the top 20% of its field. All prize money will be awarded in the form of a City of Madison Gift Card that can be picked up at the conclusion of the tournament.

Skin money will be awarded in the form of a City of Madison Gift Card that can be picked up at the conclusion of the tournament.

<u>Drawing for Season Pass, Hole in One and Door Prizes:</u> Participants that withdraw from the tournament are not eligible. (Must turn in scorecards for each day) Must be present to win door prizes, do not need to be present to win 2019 Season Pass Membership. Tournament must have a minimum 20 participants for season pass drawing to take place.
