The Madison Water Utility (MWU) is in the process of selecting a site for a new well in Pressure Zone 4 on the Southeast side of Madison. This well is being sited to ensure sufficient supply of water and water pressure for fire protection as well safe drinking water.

We would like to invite you to participate in a public meeting on Thursday, March 31, 2011 at 6:00 pm at LaFollette High School to update the community on the project and get further input on the areas being considered for siting this well.

The adjacent map shows a portion of Pressure Zone 4 and, based on an additional round of site screening, the MWU is proposing these two areas be considered as the areas for siting the new well. Within these areas, there are a number of potential vacant commercial sites large enough to site the facility. The purpose of the public meeting is to get final community input on these areas as potential well sites. .
