# New User Guide - Construction Phase

#### **Project Access**

Welcome to the Autodesk Construction Cloud! You will receive an email inviting you to the project from City of Madison Engineering. Follow the link to the project.

Login using your Autodesk account. Create an account if you don't already have one. Please note: If you have an Autodesk account and it is different from the email you receive the project invite on, please notify John Sapp and Laura Amundson (<a href="mailto:jsapp@cityofmadison.com">jsapp@cityofmadison.com</a>; <a href="mailto:jsapp@cityofmadison.com">jsapp@cityof

Note that each user is solely responsible for updating their name and must provide a contact phone number. Go to <a href="https://profiles.autodesk.com">https://profiles.autodesk.com</a> to update this information. A license has already been provided from City of Madison Engineering to access everything you will need based on your role in the project.

### **Transition from Sharepoint**

ACC will replace Sharepoint for the Construction phase of the project. The Sharepoint site for the Design phase will remain but as view-only.

Basic files associated with the project are saved in the directory structure in Files. It is very intuitive. The back button and ability to bookmark or share links all work. If something seems to have trouble loading, refresh the web page.


Plan sheets reside in Sheets. Sheets adds a lot of functionality beyond what is available in Files. In particular, it simplifies versioning and allows for pinning photos or notes to a location in a plan sheet. Sheets is also available via a mobile device in the ACC app.

Files and Sheets are the foundation of ACC and the core sections that most users will interact with. There is also much more functionality for a wide variety of construction administration workflows—see Learning Paths in Training & Reference Materials section for more details.
