I circled back with the project team and have the following responses to your questions:

- James Madison Memorial High School (AHI 107285) fields: The Project would widen the existing 5' sidewalk to 10'. It is proposed that the widening be made towards the high schools fields, to preserve the row of trees in the terrace area between the sidewalk and the road.
- Station nearest the front of the UW Central Heating Plant (AHI 114116): Correct. The station is located on the northern side of the intersection.
- Request for "low impact, more transparent stations" at the Capitol (Main and MLK) and East High (E Washington and 4th): Ridership at both stations is anticipated to be high, so the team would like to maintain the station size but is open to increasing the number of transparent panels at the two station locations.
