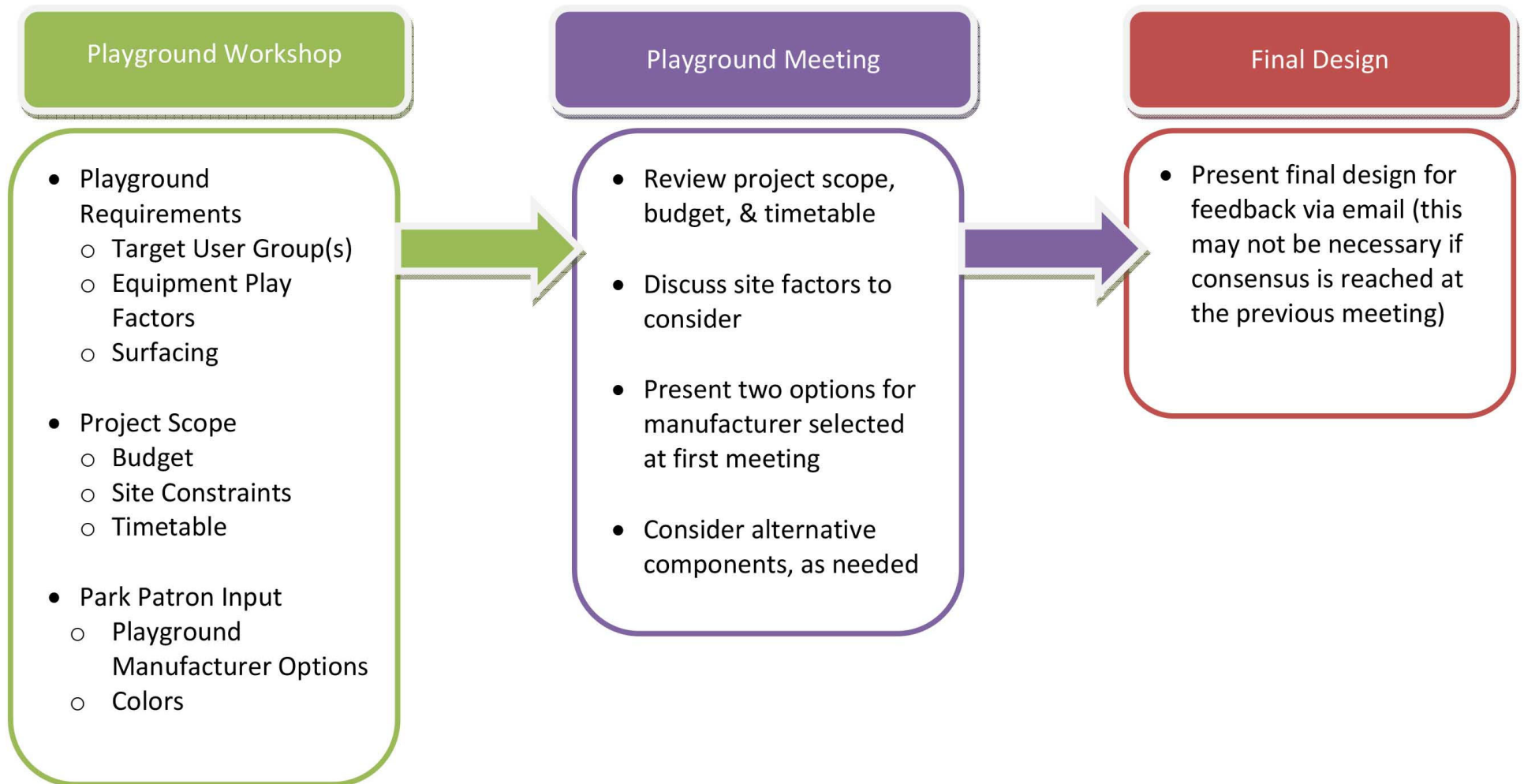
City of Madison Playgrounds

WHAT MAKES A PLAYGROUND INCLUSIVE?

- 1. Allows for users of all abilities and developmental stages to play in the same space and “side by side” wherever possible**
- 2. Considers the needs of all users and incorporates play equipment that addresses those needs**
- 3. Recognizes that individuals living with cognitive, sensory, intellectual and physical challenges benefit from play and outdoor activity**
- 4. Offers a range of experiences including tactile features, contrasting colors, sheltering/quiet zones, sound elements**

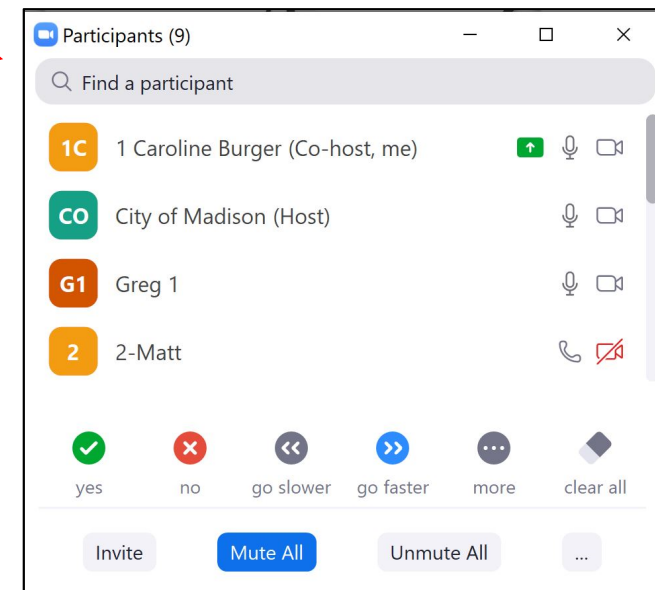
