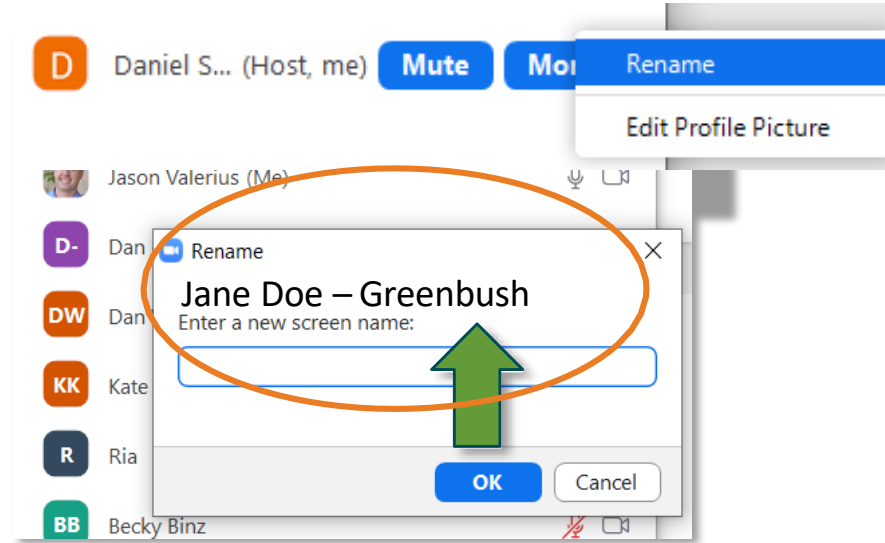


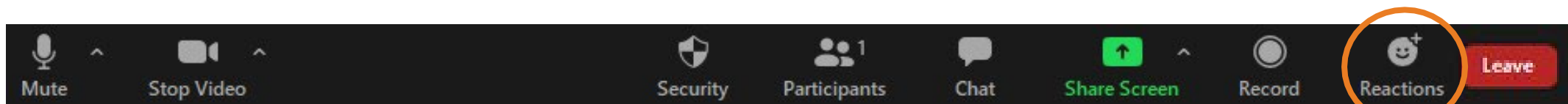

- Constructed in 1981
- Pavement repaired three times
 - Last pavement repair in 2009
- Existing issues
 - Pavement cracking
 - Poor drainage
 - Outdated hoops
 - No space for spectators

PENN PARK COURTS RECONSTRUCTION

- Spring 2023 construction
- Re-build 2 basketball courts
- Replace tennis court with a mini-pitch
 - A mini-pitch is a court based soccer pitch
 - Games are typically played with 5 players per side
 - Size similar to a tennis court

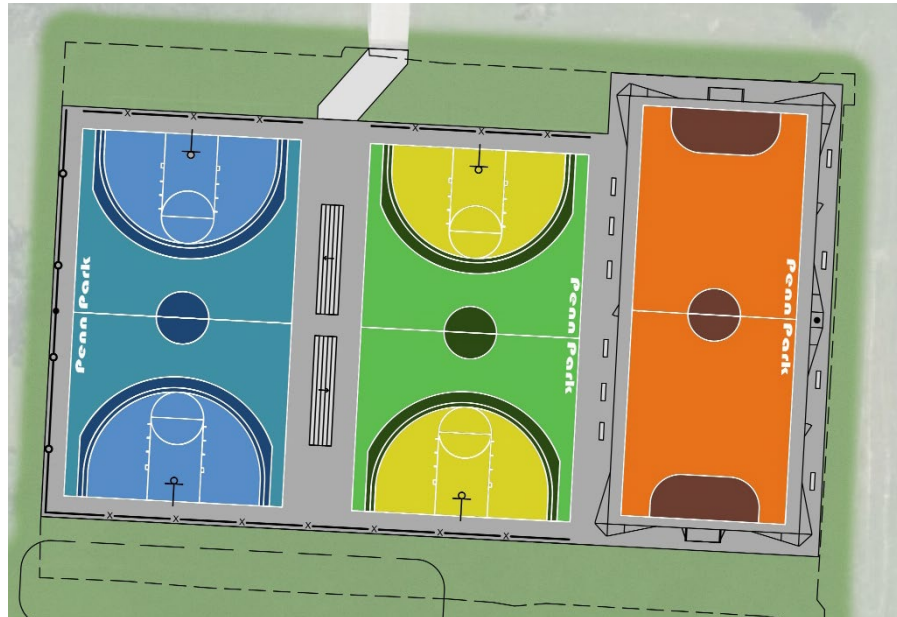
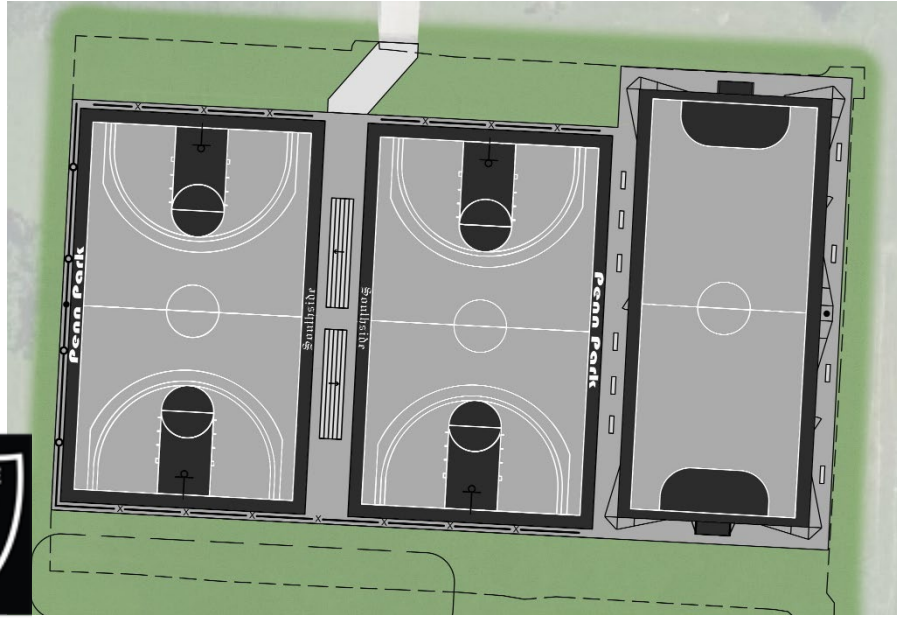
Court Surface Colors

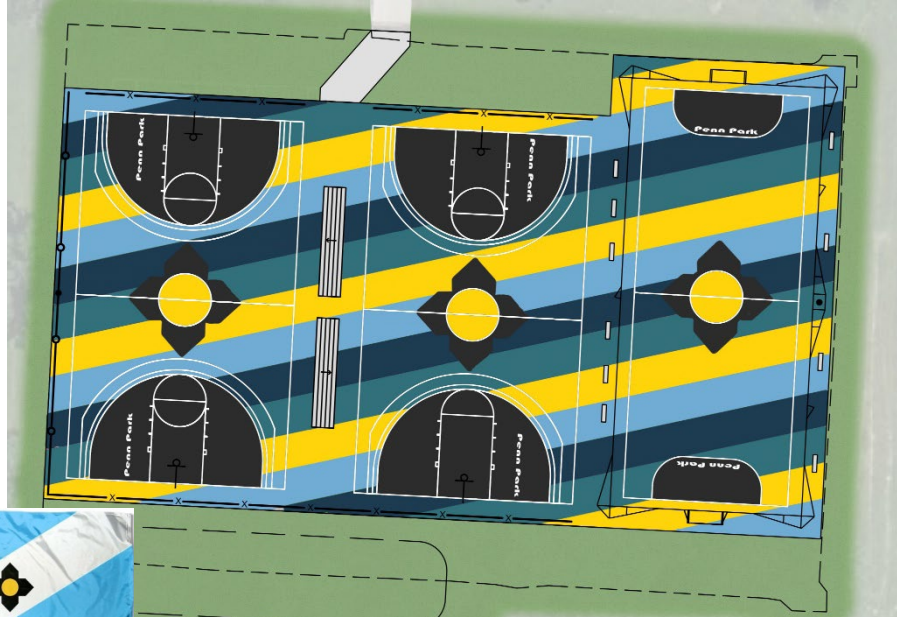
