

RICHMOND HILL PARK- EXISTING PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT






RICHMOND HILL PARK – ADJACENT PLAYGROUNDS



 - Specific requests include: web climber feature, scavenger hunt, Stability Sanctuary hammock, and a high-low slide.



Treasure Hunter FOR AGES 6-9

Biba Treasure Hunter is a challenging jungle tomb expedition where players seek out new treasures while navigating equipment challenges, dodging traps and solving mini-games. See how long your kids can last in the ancient ruins as they try to add as much unique treasure as they can add to their collection!



Collectobots FOR AGES 3-6

Biba Collectobots lets you host a scavenger hunt on the playground, as your child searches for tiny baby robots known as Biblets! Kids use or tag equipment and then bring back imaginary Biblets that they can 'drop into' the phone and take care of. Like Tamagotchi on the playground!



Dino Dig FOR AGES 4-6

Dino Dig is an archeological adventure where kids travel to dig sites through equipment usage and then play minigames on the phone to unearth dinosaur bones! Use augmented reality to dig up virtual bones right there on the playground and learn trivia tidbits about dinosaurs!



Relay FOR AGES 6-9

The ultimate two player collaborative challenge, Biba Relay tests kids' speed as they take turns trying to use equipment while timed in an effort to keep the game going for as long as possible! The higher the round, the more challenging. PLUS, with Double Dash mode, kids both run at the same time!
