

## Q1 In general, what are some of your favorite small park activities? Choose all that apply.










# Q4 How often do you visit the Madison Senior Center Courtyard? Check all that apply.


### Q5 What time of day do you visit the Madison Senior Center Courtyard?

## Q6 What type of transportation do you use to get to the Madison Senior Center Courtyard?





### Q10 Which existing amenities are important to keep and/or upgrade at the Madison Senior Center Courtyard?






