



## Registering to Vote in the City of Madison

Welcome to Madison! Our goal is for each eligible voter to be able to cast a ballot and have that ballot counted.

You can register to vote at your polling place on Election Day. You will need to show the poll workers one of these documents to prove your current name and current address:

- Utility bill that covers a time frame within the past 90 days (water, gas, electric, cable, internet, landline or cellular phone)
- Bank or credit union statement
- Current and valid Wisconsin driver license or Wisconsin identification card
- Paycheck
- Document issued by a unit of government – this is a very broad category including, but not limited to:
  - University of Wisconsin enrollment verification statement
  - Wisconsin vehicle registration
  - Wisconsin hunting or fishing license
  - City of Madison license or permit
  - Ticket or Citation
  - Document from Medicare, Medicaid, or BadgerCare
  - Social Security or Social Security Disability statement or correspondence
  - Wisconsin Works or Wisconsin Shares statement
  - University of Wisconsin or Madison College transcript or financial aid statement
  - Billing statement from a government entity
  - Document from a federally recognized Native American Tribe
- Check issued by a unit of government
- Edgewood College fee statement, accompanied by student ID
- Residential lease effective on day of registration (can't be mailed to Clerk's Office)
- Affidavit from an agency (public or private) providing homeless services

It takes 28 days to establish residency for voting purposes. If you move less than 28 days before an election you may vote at your old polling place, from your previous address.

You may register to vote up to 20 days before an election at any Madison Public Library, with proof of address.

You may mail your voter registration application and a photocopy of your proof of address to City Clerk, 210 Martin Luther King Jr Blvd #103, Madison, WI 53703. The deadline to register by mail is 20 days before an election.

You may register to vote in the City Clerk's Office through the Friday before an election, with proof of address.
