

## Guide for Determining Where a Person Votes

<b>Has moved from one ward to another in the same municipality at least 10 consecutive days before an election</b>	In the new ward
<b>Has moved from one municipality to another at least 10 consecutive days before an election</b>	In the new municipality
<b>Has moved from one ward to another in the same municipality less than 10 consecutive days before an election</b>	In the old ward
<b>Has moved from one municipality to another less than 10 consecutive days before an election</b>	In the old municipality
<b>Has moved to a different ward, or state temporarily, with intent to return</b>	In the ward or municipality where the individual lived
<b>Lives in one ward or municipality and conducts business in another</b>	In the ward or municipality where the individual lives
<b>Lives in a public or private facility, such as a federal or state institution, county home or hospital, nursing home or group home</b>	In the municipality where the facility is located Or In the municipality of residence before entering the facility
<b>Is on active duty as a member of the armed forces serving in the U.S. or overseas</b>	In the municipality or ward of residence before entering the armed services
<b>Is the spouse or dependent of a member of armed forces</b>	In the ward or municipality of residence of the military elector Or If a Wisconsin resident, municipality or ward of residence before entering the armed services
<b>Is a civilian overseas employee of the U.S. Government</b>	In the municipality or ward of residence before entry into federal employment
