Has moved from one municipality to another less than 10 consecutive days before an election	In the old municipality
Has moved to a different ward, or state temporarily, with intent to return	In the ward or municipality where the individual lived
Lives in one ward or municipality and conducts business in another	In the ward or municipality where the individual lives
Lives in a public or private facility, such as a federal or state institution, county home or hospital, nursing home or group home	In the municipality where the facility is located Or In the municipality of residence before entering the facility
