The City of Madison adopted its first historic preservation ordinance and created the Landmarks Commission in 1970. Since that time, the City has designated 182 landmarks and 5 local historic districts. Now the City plans to broaden its efforts beyond the traditional regulatory focus to a more dynamic and comprehensive approach that more completely includes under-represented communities in Madison's unique story.
